

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS ABOUT YOUR GIFTS TO UNITY CHURCH OF OVERLAND PARK

QUESTION: I want to include Unity Church of Overland Park in my will. What types

of gifts will you accept?

ANSWER: Thank you for your thoughtfulness and generosity. By including Unity

Church of Overland Park in your will or estate plan, you are

demonstrating your faith and belief in the mission and vision of our church and that you wish to further these good works. We accept the following

types of gifts:

Bequest of a percentage of the estate.

Bequest of cash.

Life Insurance.

Retained Life Insurance.

Retirement Assets.

Securities, stocks and bonds. Tangible Personal Property.

QUESTION: What is the full legal name for Unity Church of Overland Park that I

should include in my will?

ANSWER: Gifts may be designated to Unity Church of Living Truth. Gifts should

not be designated to a specific individual or individuals. The Church, its staff, employees, Board of Directors and agents should not be designated

in a will as a personal representative for a donor's estate.

QUESTION: Should I specify the use of my gift?

ANSWER: When considering how you would like your gift to be used, you may specify its use as "unrestricted" or "restricted." If neither of these terms is used, the gift is treated as "unrestricted." An unrestricted gift may be used for any purpose as determined by the leadership of Unity Church of Overland Park, while a restricted gift will be specified for an intended use.

QUESTION: My family is large and has some special needs, but I do want to include a gift to Unity Church of Overland Park in my will. Is there a minimum gift amount that I may give?

ANSWER: A gift of any amount is a loving and generous act. Thank you for considering the future of Unity Church of Overland Park as you make your own future plans.

QUESTION: I have made a decision to include Unity Church of Overland Park in my will. Who should I notify?

ANSWER: Please contact our Business Manager to let us know of your generosity.

QUESTION: I would like to remain anonymous. Is that possible?

ANSWER: We hope that you will inform us when you have named Unity Church of Overland Park in your will. We would very much like the opportunity to thank you for your generosity, and informing us of your gift allows for us to include you in any appreciation events and communication. Also, recognition of your gift may encourage others do the same. However, if you prefer to remain anonymous, your gift will be kept completely confidential.
