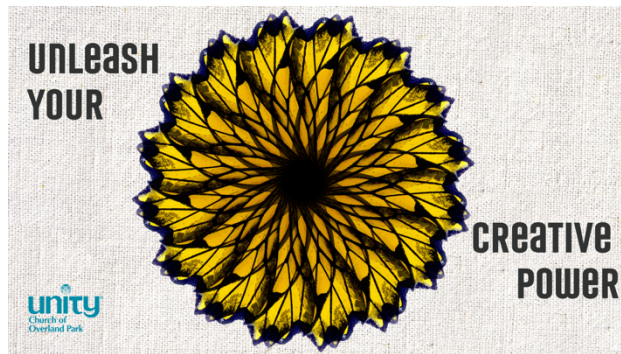


Supply List



7/10:

- camera of any kind (phone camera will do);
- play dough (can be easily made from scratch with items you likely have in your pantry, or purchase a single color cannister);
- select an object from around the house to have near you - it can be literally anything at all that you can easily place on a table or desk;
- be sure you have workspace to freely use playdough.

7/17: NO CLASS/Annual Meeting

7/24:

- tempura paint (as few or as many color options as you want);
- paint brush;
- painting paper (ideally 11x14 or larger);

NOTE: If you already have a different paint (watercolor or oil pastels, etc) feel free to use what you have. This isn't about learning painting techniques as much as it is about creative expression: tempura is inexpensive and can be used freely without concern for waste.

7/31: No supplies needed - wear comfortable clothes

8/7:

- crayons,
- pencils, or colored pencils
- copy paper or drawing paper
- if you can have a larger poster paper available, that would be handy

8/14:

- Multi-media (a range of found objects: for example, soda can, pipe cleaners, yarn/string, screws/nails, ribbon, feathers, small wood pieces or sticks, etc.)
- hot glue gun would be handy, or any kind of glue or tape;
- scissors, paint/paintbrush if desired.

Give yourself enough items to be creative with, we will discuss more details the week before this session.
